

The work-package on ELSI and Public Engagement the Austrian node BBMRI.at participated in July 2016 at Kinderuni – the annual University for children organised by the University of Vienna – where children aged between 6 and 14 attend courses on diverse topics.

The researchers confronted the children aged between 6 and 10 with the same scenario as they apply in the Citizen-Expert panels; group discussions aiming at investigating the attitudes and fears related to tissue donning and data storage in biobanks. When asked whether they would be willing to give consent to tissue donation, the children were enthusiastic but also keen to know what happens next.
