

## ACCESS PRINCIPLES TO BBMRI-ERIC SELF-ASSESSMENT SURVEYS (BBMRI-ERIC SAS)

The BBMRI-ERIC Self-Assessment Surveys (SAS) help to determine relevant requirements for your work processes defined in the respective standard. You can do this assessment process (including a remote or on-site audit) together with BBMRI-ERIC, and if there is a positive outcome of the audit, it can lead to a Q-mark in the BBMRI-ERIC Directory.

Short explanation about the access prerequisites:

1) Is your organisation located in a BBMRI-ERIC member/observer state?

If your organisation is located in neither a member nor observer state or you are a private business, we can give you access to our BBMRI-ERIC SAS against a contribution to expenses. Simply request the specific Self-Assessment Surveys in the form or you contact the BBMRI.QM team via <a href="mailto:email">email</a>. You will be contacted by BBMRI.QM within 3 business days.
